Reginald Daniel was a former communications analyst with the U.S. Air Force and a top-earning salesman with Silicon Graphics before he founded SES with just three employees in his basement in 1996. SES has successfully competed against giants such as Lockheed Martin and Booz Allen Hamilton to secure more than \$45 million in worldwide business in its first five years.

Based in the Washington, D.C. and Baltimore, Maryland area, the company averaged growth of 35% per year and won over \$200 million in contracts, delivering unsurpassed quality and support to all of the company's clients under Mr. Daniel's leadership. In 2004, the Maryland Technology Council, Prince George's County Chapter named Daniel Entrepreneur of The Year.
